History of Wood County

In the winter of 1827, Daniel Whitney of Green Bay obtained a permit from the Winnebago granting him the privilege of making shingles on the Wisconsin River. He employed 22 Stockbridge Indians and conveyed them to the mouth of the Yellow River. In 1831 Daniel Whitney obtained a permit from the War Dept. to erect a sawmill and cut timber on the Wisconsin River. In 1831-2, assisted by his nephew and A.B. Sampson, built the first mill at the place known as Whitney's Rapids, below Point Basse, and about 10 miles south of Wisconsin Rapids. Messrs, Grignon & Merrill, having also obtained a permit, built a mill at Grignon's Rapids in 1836. These two establishments were the first lumbering plants on the Wisconsin River in Wood County.

Wood County was named after Joseph Wood, who came here from Illinois in 1848. Under Chapter 54 Laws of 1856, present Wood County was detached from Portage County. The same chapter directed that the town board of supervisors of the town of Grand Rapids in Wood County, shall be the board of supervisors of Wood County until a county board shall be elected and qualified as provided by the revised statutes of the same act. The first election was held in November 1856. The first county officers were: County Judge Joseph Wood; Sheriff Benjamin Buck; District Attorney L.P. Powers; Surveyor H.A. Temple; Clerk of Circuit Courts L. Kromer; County Clerk L.P. Powers; Treasurer I.L. Moser; Register of Deeds, L. Kromer. The county board met for the first time October 8, 1856.

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History of Wood County

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Towns were established as follows: Rudolph- Oct.8, 1856; Saratoga- Jan. 9, 1857; Seneca- June 9. 1857; Dexter- March 10, 1858; Lincoln-Dec. 25, 1861; Sigel- Jan. 10, 1863; Remington- July 15, 1868; Wood- Feb. 10, 1874; Port Edwards- Feb. 10, 1874: Auburndale- Dec. 30, 1874: Marshfield- Dec. 3, 1875; Rock- Jan. 23, 1878; Richfield- Nov. 18, 1881; Milladore- Feb. 15, 1882; Sherry- Nov. 10, 1885; Hansen- Nov. 10 1885; Cary- Feb. 13, 1901; Arpin- Feb. 13, 1901; Hiles- Nov. 15, 1901; Cameron- Nov. 18, 1903; Cranmoor- Nov. 18, 1903; Centralia- Jan 9, 1857; Springfield- Aug. 27, 1861 and McClellan- May 26, 1864. Centralia is now part of Wisconsin Rapids. Springfield was vacated Feb 23. 1865 and attached to McClellan which was reorganized and shortly afterward vacated and the territory was distributed to other towns.

On Jan. 5, 1858 the board adopted the Wood County Reporter as its official newspaper to publish all proceedings. This paper was established in Nov. 1857 and was the first and only newspaper in the county. The first courthouse was a hall in the Magnolia House which was located on the corner of Ninth and Washington Ave. The first court was held there in 1857. The date of the first warranty deed recorded was Oct 1856. The first building actually erected as a courthouse in Wood County was built in Grand Rapids on a spot near the river. The population of Wood County in 1860 was 2425.

WISCONSIN MARRIAGE LAW AND DOMESTIC PARTNERSHIP REQUIREMENTS ELIGIBILITY

AGE: Every person who has attained the age of 18 years may marry. If a person is between the age of 16 and 18 years a license may be issued with written consent. A court can no longer grant special permission for a person under age 16. No one under the age of 18 may apply for a Domestic Partnership.

RELATIONSHIP: Persons closer in relationship than second cousins may not marry or enter into a Domestic Partnership. First cousins may marry where the wife is age 55 or older or where either party at time of application for marriage license submits an affidavit signed by a physician stating that either party is permanently sterile.

PRIOR MARRIAGES / PARTNERSHIPS: A party to a divorce is prohibited from marrying in Wisconsin within 6 months of the granting of divorce, regardless of what state granted the divorce. Domestic Partnerships have a 90 day waiting period from the date the last termination was filed.

LICENSE

APPLICATION: Both applicants must apply in person. At the time of application, both must submit certified copies of their birth certificates, driver's license or Wisconsin ID with your current address, (if your address is not current on your driver's license, please bring other proof of residence), and social security numbers. Persons who were previously married or in a Domestic Partnership must submit proof of how their last marriage / partnership ended by bringing their Judgment of Divorce, death certificate or Domestic Partnership Termination papers.

WAITING PERIOD: Application must be made to the County Clerk's Office at least 5 days before the marriage / ceremony, providing all qualifications are met.

RESIDENCE: Application must be made in the county where at least one party has resided for at least 30

days. If both parties are out-of-state residents, application must be made in the county where the ceremony is to be performed.

OATH: Parties must take oath that marriage / partnership will be lawful and that information given in the application as to age, relationship and prior marriages is correct.

EXPIRATIONS: A marriage license is valid for 30 days after it is issued. A Domestic Partnership certificate does not expire.

MARRIAGE CEREMONY

OFFICIALS: Judges of Court of Record, ordained ministers and priests and Court Commissioners may perform the ceremony.

WITNESSES: Two adult (18 years of age) witnesses are required in addition to person officiating, but do not have to be in the wedding party.

VALIDITY

NON-RESIDENT: Marriage in Wisconsin of non-residents who are prohibited from marrying in the state of their residence is null and void.

OUT-OF-STATE: Marriage of Wisconsin residents in another state is null and void if such marriage would be prohibited in Wisconsin.

RESPONSIBILITY OF OFFICES / INFO

AGING & DISABILITY RESOURCE CENTER OF CENTRAL WI:

ADRC-CW promotes choice and independence through information, personalized options counseling, advocacy, and access to services which prevent, delay, and lesson the impacts of aging and disabilities. We serve adults age 60 years and older and individuals 18 years or older with physical disabilities, developmental disabilities, mental health concerns, substance abuse issues, as well as their families, caregivers, and friends. Our service includes Langlade, Lincoln, Marathon, and Wood Counties and we have offices in Antigo, Marshfield, Merrill, Wausau, and Wisconsin Rapids.

CHILD SUPPORT:

Establish paternities, legal obligations to pay child support, and medical insurance orders; responsibility of taking administrative, civil and criminal legal actions necessary to enforce child support orders; review and/or modify court orders to monitor and adjust child support financial accounts when necessary.

CIRCUIT COURT JUDGES:

Criminal felonies, misdemeanors and ordinances; DNR violations; small claims cases; large claims cases; divorce cases; foreclosures; paternity cases; other civil court matters; all probate and trust cases; mental & alcoholic cases; all juvenile court cases; adoptions; guardianships and protective placement cases.

CLERK OF COURTS:

Ordinance violations, traffic and criminal cases; divorce, paternity and small claims cases; civil & criminal action; judgments; certificates of conviction; mechanics liens; state income tax liens and jury duty.

COMMUNICATIONS:

Responsible for repairs and maintains communications systems for the Wood County department agencies. Coordinates and keeps up-to-date the warning communications procedures and capabilities to be employed in the event of a large-scale emergency in Wood County.

CORPORATION COUNSEL:

Responsible for representing Wood County in all civil legal proceedings, both in actions by and against the county; contract drafting and review; mental and alcohol commitments, guardianships and protective placements for the indigent; legal counsel to the county board, its committees, commissions, agencies and departments; represents the state in child support matters.

COUNTY CLERK:

County board records/county board secretary; elections; marriage licenses; declarations/terminations of domestic partnerships; passport agent; DMV services; dog license records; timber cutting permits; notary public; farmland preservation agreement filing.

CORONER:

The legal duties and responsibilities of the Coroner include determining the cause of any death that falls under their legal jurisdiction. Such deaths include suicides, homicides, accidental deaths, and deaths from natural causes. A large percentage of the deaths investigated are natural deaths that are unexpected or unexplained. If necessary, the Coroner will request a forensic specialist to perform additional services, such as an autopsy or toxicology testing. The Coroner is often the primary contact for the grieving family looking for answers. The coroner must approve all cremations, which cannot proceed without the coroner's OK.

DISPATCH CENTER:

The Wood County Dispatch Center is responsible for poviding the means by which the general public may report the existence of an incident requiring fire, police, or ambulance response; and to provide the means by which the incoming reports and requests are received, managed, and disseminated in a timely manner to the proper personnel and agencies. The Wood County Dispatch Center is committed to providing the people of Wood County the help they need when they need it the most.

DISTRICT ATTORNEY:

Prosecution of all criminal actions, state forfeiture actions, county traffic actions, actions concerning violations of county ordinance, John Doe proceedings, grand jury proceedings, criminal appeals, juvenile proceedings and certain civil actions or special proceedings.

EDGEWATER HAVEN NURSING HOME:

Edgewater is Wood County's nursing home. It provides the highest quality of care for citizens who through age or infirmity, become incapable of functioning without licensed nursing supervision and a structured living environment 24 hours per day. Departments of the nursing home include: nursing, housekeeping, dietary, laundry, maintenance, occupational and physical therapies, activities, social services and administration. The facility serves the health care and rehabilitation needs of elders of Wood County and surrounding communities. Oversight and funding is provided by Medicare, Medicaid and the Veteran's Administration. Private pay clients, tax levy and private insurance serve as other sources of revenue for the facility.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT:

Assist local government in the protection of lives, property and the environment in the event of major emergencies or disaster of any nature; allow for the assessment of hazards, mitigation opportunities, response capabilities, resources and needs; identify and deploy resources effectively and allocate emergency responsibilities and authority among

local government agencies; coordinate activities among agencies and all levels of government; record information, decisions and procedures developed during the planning process and during actual emergency situations; provide a basis for training and exercising personnel to operate in coordination; responsible for: building number identification program (BNI), highway safety program, community service work program and SARA Title III program.

FINANCE:

Responsible for county-wide financial record- keeping. Prepares internal and external interim and year-end financial reports. Coordinates, summaries and documents the annual budget process and the five-year capital improvement plan. Issues payments to County vendors. Responsible for preparing, coordinating and assisting in the annual audit

HEALTH:

The mission of the Health Department is to maximize the quality of life across the lifespan. The Health Department's primary areas of responsibility focus on Family Health and Injury Prevention, Health Promotion and Chronic Disease Prevention, Communicable Disease Investigation and Follow-up. Emergency Preparedness, Public Health Ordinance Enforcement. and Oral Health Education. Woman, Infants, and Children (WIC) is a federally funded program, which provides eligible clients with supplemental food nutrition, health education, and referral services. addition, the Health Department is responsible for code enforcement, licensing, and inspection of all Wood County restaurants, retail food establishments, hotels/motels. mobile home campgrounds, recreational/educational facilities. tattooing and body piercing, school kitchens, and vending machines.

HIGHWAY:

Responsible for all maintenance, construction, engineering, snow and ice removal and all signing for 324.38 miles of county trunk highways as well as purchasing and repair of all equipment to accomplish this work; maintains an administrative staff for all accounting and ordering of equipment and supplies.

HUMAN RESOURCES:

Wood County is committed to providing excellent service to Wood County residents in all County endeavors. Wood County is also committed to managing in keeping with positive employee relations.

In keeping with this Mission, the Wood County Human Resources Department is committed to:

- Insure that County departments have employees who are skilled, trained and committed to their individual missions or assignments at all levels of County government.
- Provide counsel, advice, direct services and assistance relating to work hours, wages, working conditions, staffing, labor relations, human resources and training of employees, ensuring that all these activities are conducted in both the spirit and intent of State and Federal programs and mandates in a fiscally prudent manner.
- Counsel the Wood County management team and work to implement policies and practices that are identified as a "best practice" to develop and maintain positive employee relations.

HUMAN SERVICES:

Human Services offers a wide range of services: Transportation services for the citizens over the age of 55 and individuals with disabilities; Medical (XIX); Food Share; Food Assistance Employment & Training; Foster Care for Children; Child Welfare Services and Juvenile Court services; a range of services for individuals with alcohol and other drug abuse, and mental health services for all ages; crisis intervention, mobile crisis services, and outpatient clinic services; inpatient services Norwood Health Center; community support programs; Comprehensive Community Services for children and adults; special living arrangements and extended care; commitments; Adult Protective Service investigations; guardianship and protective placements. Also offers services for children with developmental disabilities and autism through the Birth to Three Program such as early intervention, service coordination, speech therapy, physical therapy, and occupational therapy; children's long term support waivers; and through the Family Support program providing goods and services for families caring for children with severe disabilities from birth to age twenty-one.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY:

Mission: The Wood County Information Technology Department is a service organization dedicated to delivering reliable and secure voice and computer systems that are necessary to acquire, organize, preserve, and access information used by Wood County employees and the citizens of Wood County. Activities: The Information Technology Department provides employees with uninterrupted, round-the-clock access to phone and computer systems. It also distributes operating system upgrades and new applications across the county's entire network; engineers and manages network infrastructure, servers, PCs, and applications across various locations; designs and creates in house applications; provides vendor application installation and support.

LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION:

The Department recommends and designs the best management practices for soil conservation and water quality protection to be installed by individual

landowners, farmers and units of government. Department administers the following programs: Wildlife Damage Abatement and Claims Program, Preservation Program, Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program, Land and Water Resource Management Program and the Nonmetallic Mining Reclamation Program; including an information and education program, committee support and of the Animal Waste. administration Management and Groundwater Protection ordinance, wildlife tree and shrub sale, tree planter rental, general soil and water conservation activities, and technical to the U.S.D.A. Natural Conservation Service for implementation of the current Farm Bill programs.

MAINTENANCE/PURCHASING:

Responsible for the property management of the courthouse, jail, annex, joint use building and Human Services 12th Street offices and River Block; develops and/or supervises all architectural and engineering construction; maintenance of all general building structures, air conditioning; electrical, grounds, security, housekeeping and purchasing.

NORWOOD HEALTH CENTER:

Provides residents of Wood and surrounding counties with quality treatment services which include acute inpatient psychiatric care, a skilled long-term care unit for the chronically mentally ill, and a sub acute traumatic brain injury rehabilitation and treatment unit. Norwood Health Center is owned by Wood County and operated by the Wood County Health and Human Service Committee. No Wood County resident is denied services because of an inability to pay.

PARKS & FORESTRY:

Maintains and Operates nine parks or areas: North Wood County Park, Richfield 360 Area, South Wood County Park, Wood County ATV Area, Dexter County Park, Powers Bluff County Park, Nepco County Park, Wood County Public Rifle Range, 271.68 miles of Snowmobile Trails and 37,684.42 acres of County Forest Land

PLANNING & ZONING:

Planning functions: Prepares/maintains comprehensive plan • prepare topic-specific plans to maintain eligibility for grants • assists

municipalities with planning-related coordinates multi-jurisdictional planning programs provides staff assistance to several county board committees on physical and social planning

programs • census data clearinghouse • provides technical assistance for county redistricting.

Code enforcement functions: Administers/ enforces Private Sewage Ordinance (processes and issues permits for private on-site waste treatment systems, inspects system installations, administers Wisconsin Fund Grant Program, develops/maintains private on-site waste treatment system maintenance program and electronic reporting database, reviews soil test

reports) • administers and enforces Shoreland Zoning Ordinance, Floodplain Zoning Ordinance (reviews FEMA

floodplain maps) and Land

Subdivision Ordinance (working with surveyors and developers, prepares site plan reviews and reviews proposed land divisions) • reviews DNR

wetland maps for compliance with state and county development requirements.

Land Records functions: Administers Wood

County's Land Records Modernization program prepares and maintains the County Land Records Modernization plan • maintains county Geographic Information System, including hardware, software, base data and parcel maps • prepares custom maps for county departments, public and private use.

Economic Development functions: Administers county revolving loan fund • coordinates county economic development programs • prepares grants for bicycle trails and economic development projects.

REGISTER IN PROBATE:

Wills; informal, formal and special administrations: summary assignments & settlements; transfers by (\$50.000 and under): administrations; trusts; guardianships and protective placements; adoptions; mental and alcoholic ordinances. commitments: iuvenile iuvenile delinguencies: CHIPS and JIPS cases termination of parental rights case.

REGISTER OF DEEDS:

Deeds & mortgages; land contracts, etc.; uniform commercial code filings; conditional sales contracts; bills of sale; copies of birth, death, marriage and domestic partnership certificates; soldiers discharge.

RISK MANAGEMENT:

Worker's Compensation claims, property insurance, liability insurance, safety (compliance with the Department of Safety and Professional Services regulations).

SHERIFF:

Oversees the jail division, patrol division and administration. Jail division: Maintains a 132-bed jail facility. Patrol division: Consists of 26 patrol deputies. Responds to all emergency calls for the townships in Wood County. Administration: Consists of six investigators, two secretaries, one Chief Deputy, one Investigative Captain, one Patrol Captain, one jail Captain, four Patrol Lieutenants, two Jail Lieutenants and a special response team, which responds to critical incidents and is highly trained and equipped to handle many situations. The Department also provides boat and snowmobile patrol.

SURVEYOR:

Maintains land survey records and performs duties under Wis. Statutes Section 59.45. Coordinates the maintenance of the Public Land Survey System. Responsible for improving the accessibility, quality, completeness and longevity of land survey records.

TREASURER:

Real estate tax, tax descriptions & plat maps; tax deeded property & tax sales; county & private forest crop lands.

UNIVERSITY EXTENSION:

Provides education to county residents utilizing researchbased programs; provides back-up counseling conducts applied research; coordinates 4-H program including 27 4-H clubs; 200+ volunteers and over 800 4-H'ers; junior fair exhibits; three summer camps; general youth programs and community-based youth programs; provides education to all types of agricultural producers dairy, beef, swine, crop and cranberry includina: producers, along with in-depth farm transfer counseling; horticulture assistant helps residents with gardening and landscape questions or problems including disease and insect damage, fertility, planting, fertilizing, harvesting, pruning, etc.; family living educator educates residents about nutrition and food preservation and safety, parenting and healthy family life; advises the Wood County Association for Home & Community Education (HCE); CRD agent provides natural resource, local government and economic development education to residents. The Nutrition Educator works with income eligible audiences to educate youth, adults and seniors on dietary quality, food safety and food resource management skills.

VETERANS:

Provides advice and assistance to veterans and their families on state and federal veteran's benefits to include; registration of discharge, service connected disability claims, veteran's life insurance, loans, grants, education assistance, VA health care, pension, burial allowance, and gravestone/markers.

VICTIM/WITNESS:

Operates under the authority of the district attorney to provide court preparation and support; notification as to criminal case status and disposition as well as provides information on victim rights.

WORKSITE WELLNESS PROGRAM: To provide a worksite culture and environment which supports making healthy lifestyle choices. Implement a comprehensive worksite wellness program which educates, empowers, and engages Wood County employees and their families to adopt and maintain healthy lifestyle behaviors.
