

# **Wisconsin Well Woman Program (WWWP)**

**WWWP provides preventative screening services for breast and cervical cancer (i.e. mammogram and Pap/pelvic exam) at *no cost* to you if:**

- You are between the ages of 35-64 (some limited eligibility exceptions apply to women ages 35-44 years; contact the local coordinator for details)**
- Your income meets program guidelines (250% of Federal Poverty Level)**
- You are uninsured or underinsured (your insurance doesn't cover breast and cervical cancer screening, or you are unable to pay high deductibles and co-payments)**

**The Well Woman Program does not pay for treatment of conditions other than breast or cervical cancer, even if those conditions were found during a Well Woman check up.**

**A woman who is diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer or a precancerous cervical lesion while enrolled in WWWP may be eligible for Wisconsin Well Woman Medicaid (WWWMA), which covers treatment costs for breast and cervical cancer.**
