Even though your baby is growing up and visiting the doctor less frequently doesn't mean that they don't need anymore vaccinations! There are still many important vaccinations that children should receive after 1 year of age. Follow the immunization schedule below to keep your child healthy and protect them from vaccine preventable diseases!

**All Children need immunizations  
at the following ages:**

- ♥ 2 months
- ♥ 4 months
- ♥ 6 months
- ♥ 12-23 months
- ♥ 4-6 years
- ♥ 11-12 years

And a flu vaccine is recommended annually for all children aged 6 months-18 years.
