



## Step By Step: How To Access Interactive Map

1. Go to [www.co.wood.wi.us](http://www.co.wood.wi.us)
2. On the right hand of the screen under popular topics click Interactive Maps & GIS Data.



3. Click on the Interactive GIS Map link.



4. Click click to continue.

5. In the top right corner click 2010 imagery.



6. Scroll forward with your mouse to zoom in, scroll backward with your mouse to zoom out.
7. Locate on the map where you would like to place the pond.
8. In the top right corner click Data Layers, to access ability to turn on and off layers.
9. Click to check the layers that you would like to turn on (FEMA Flood Hazards, Wetlands, Shoreland Zoning Buffer).



\* Zoom in to your property if you can not see the layers turned on.

10. Depending on what color scheme you see where you would like to build the pond, reference the color descriptions in this brochure.

## What Do All Those Colors Mean?

Green portions relates to the flood-plain. If the proposed pond is going to be in this shaded portion you need to contact Wood County Planning and Zoning at (715)-421-8471 for the correct permit.



Blue portions relates to the shoreland zoning buffer. If the proposed pond is going to be in this shaded portion you need to contact Wood County Planning and Zoning at (715)-421-8471 for the correct permit.
