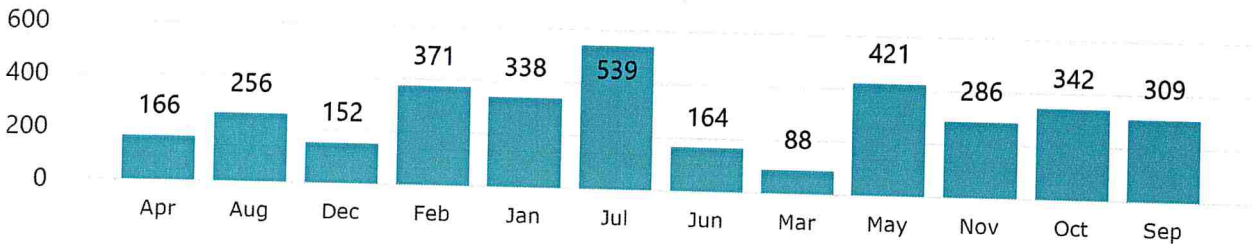

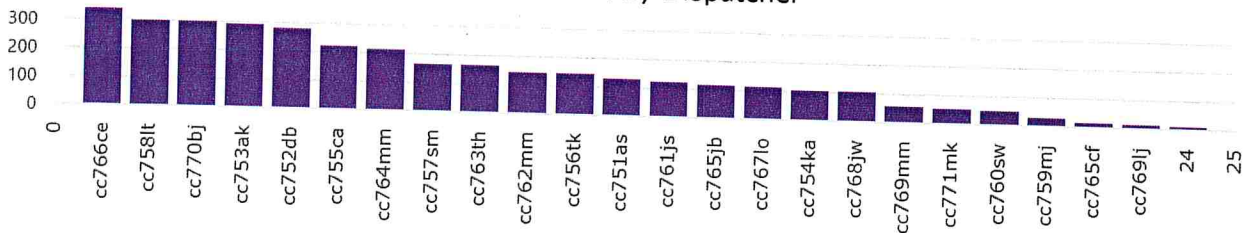

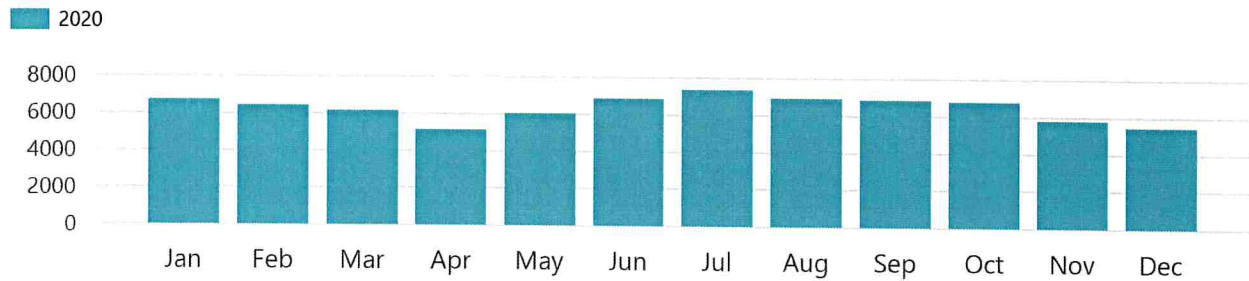

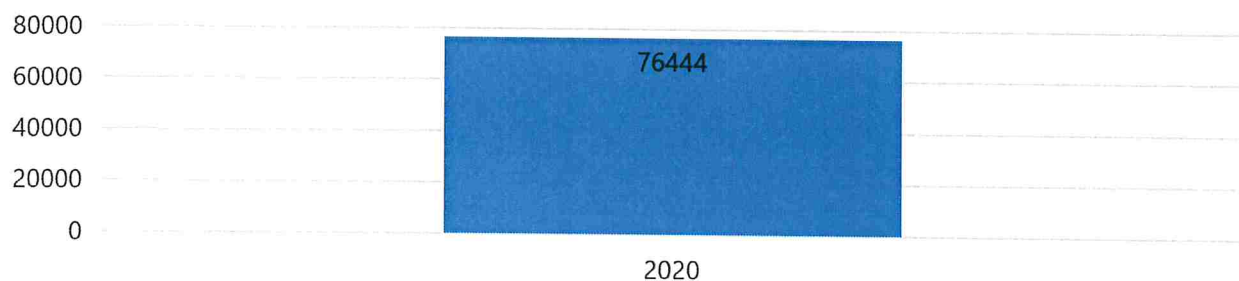

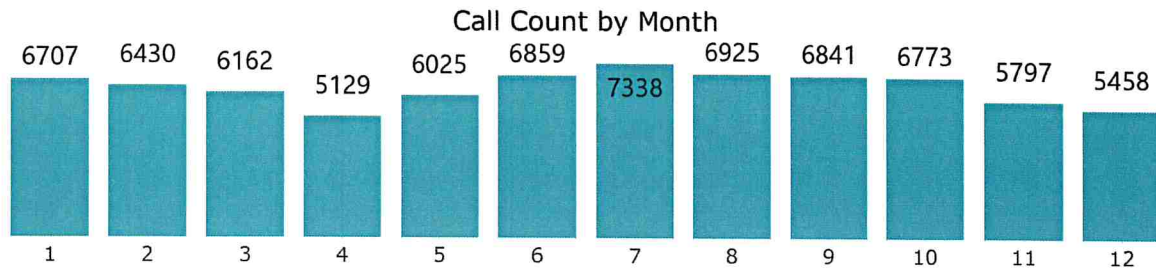

The virus also mutates in people. Environmental Health wants to reach out to the workers at the Mink ranch to offer Covid vaccinations. I did look into finding the names and address of the Mink Farm. No per diem.

Contacted by the Chairperson for the Town of Marshfield requesting my thoughts on which breeds of dogs that seem to bite and cause more damage than other breeds. Also discussed listing breeds of dogs that bite in my Reports. No per diem.

January 26th Contacted by Dispatch to please talk with a complainant who did not want to speak to the deputy that had the case regarding his dogs being shot by his neighbor when they were inside the neighbor's goat pen attacking the goat. The Humane Society had not heard from the owner nor the deputy involved, nor dispatch that requested them to pick up the cat. They were wondering who was going to pay the bill. I made contact with the Sheriff's Dept. and asked to speak with someone familiar with the case. And gave advice on options on how to handle it next time so the County isn't potentially responsible for such high veterinarian bills. 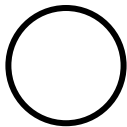

WHEREAS, the Wood County Sheriff’s Department budget is restricted in nature and would be compensated \$57,910 for additional technology purchases that would allow work and services to be accomplished remotely, and

WHEREAS, the Wood County Sheriff’s Department has limited options currently available to allow work and services to be accomplished remotely, and

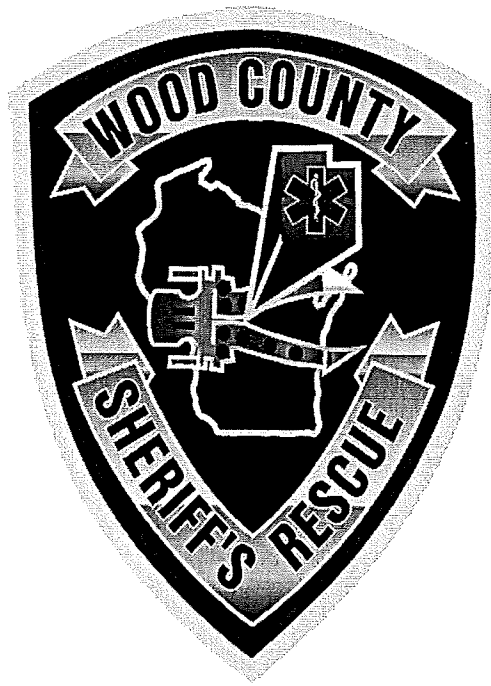
