WINTER RECREATION UPDATE

December 21, 2022

For Immediate Release:

Powers Bluff Winter Recreation Area will open on Monday, December 26th for the **second session which is 1pm – 4pm**. From Tuesday, December 27 through Sunday, January 1, Powers Bluff will be open during normal hours, 10am – 4pm.

Trail update: Nepco Ski Trail is packed and tracks are set. They are in fair condition with a 3" base. Powers Bluff multi-use trail is packed and is in fair condition with a 4" base. Powers Bluff single track trail has been packed, except for the hill climb segment which will not be packed in the winter months.

Richfield 360 multi-use trail remains closed until further notice due to branches/trees down from last snowstorm.

Snowmobile Clubs are busy getting their trails ready for opening.
