Over 17,000 middle class well educated adults

The 10 ACES

- Parents divorced or separated
- Physical abuse
- Physical neglect
- Emotional abuse
- Emotional neglect
- Sexual abuse
- Witnessed domestic violence
- Substance abuse in the household
- Mental illness in the household
- Family member in prison

0 = 33%

1 = 26%

2 = 16%

3 = 10%

4 or more = 16%

0 = 29%

1 = 13%

2 = 20%
