


MINUTES OF THE JUDICIAL AND LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE

DATE: July 28, 2014

 MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairman William Clendenning, Gerald Nelson, Gary Allworden, Ed Wagner, Bill Leichtnam

At 9 a.m., Chairman Clendenning called the meeting to order.

1. Public comments. Rhonda Carrell spoke in favor of controlling manure irrigation spreading. Bruce Dimick and Bruce Walker are Saratoga residents who also spoke in support of the county having a manure irrigation spraying ordinance. Several attendees spoke against the county taking action with the ordinance.
2. No legislators were present and no discussion had on correspondence or legislative issues.
3. There was a lot of discussion by the committee and input by the attendees on the ordinance for manure irrigation spreading. Moved by Wagner, seconded by Nelson, to not have the draft ordinance go to the county board but instead to authorize the committee chair to appoint a study group to work on the ordinance and bring it back to the committee. All ayes.
 Chairman Clendenning advised the committee he was appointing Leichtnam and Wagner to the study group. Moved by Wagner, seconded by Nelson, to confirm the appointments. All ayes.
4. Resolution for Medicaid/BadgerCare referendum. Some discussion had. Consensus of the committee that the resolution looks fine as drafted.
5. The draft Resolution for minimum wage referendum looks appropriate and after discussion and input, the committee signed it.
 Scott Larson of MACCI spoke in opposition to increasing the minimum wage. Chairman Pliml advised that just having the county board pass a resolution of this type sends out a message of an anti-business climate. Some others spoke in favor and some spoke against the proposal.
6. Resolution to allow for multiple compensated meetings on county board day. Discussion had. Committee was satisfied with the language in the draft and signed it.
7. Resolution opposing proposed reduction in state funding to the circuit court system. The Committee reviewed and signed the resolution.
8. Moved by Nelson, seconded by Wagner, to adjourn. All ayes.
 Meeting adjourned at 10:35 a.m.
