- Non-aerosol sprays*
- Inhalers
- Creams*
- Vials
- Pet medications
- Liquids*

Not Accepted

- Illegal drugs
- Needles/sharps**
- Aerosol cans
- Bio-hazardous materials (anything containing a bodily fluid or blood)
- Mercury thermometers
- Personal care products (shampoo, soaps, lotions, sunscreens, etc.)
- Household hazardous waste (paint, pesticides, oil, gas)

*Liquids, creams, and sprays must be in their original packaging; any without the original packaging will not be accepted.

**Hospitals and the Marshfield Police Department have sharps disposal areas.
