Chapter 911 .01 DEFINITIONS

The definition of terms for purposes of this Ordinance shall be the same as those set forth in Chapter 756 of the Wisconsin Statutes (2003-2004).

Chapter 911 .02 PROVISION OF STATE LAW ADOPTED BY REFERENCE

This ordinance adopts by reference sec. 756.30 (3), Wisconsin Statutes (2003-2004). Thus, any person lawfully summoned to attend circuit court as a juror who fails to attend without any sufficient excuse shall pay a forfeiture as described below.

Chapter 911 .03 PENALTIES

The penalty for violation of this Ordinance shall be a forfeiture of not more than forty dollars (\$40.00) per violation plus court costs. Each day that a violation occurs is a separate offense.

Chapter 911 .04 ENFORCEMENT

The Wood County Clerk of Circuit Court and the Wood County Sheriff's Department shall have the authority to enforce this Ordinance and shall have authority to issue citations pursuant to sec. 66.0113, Wis. Stats. for violations of this Ordinance. The Wood County Clerk of Circuit Court may delegate this authority to employees.

Citation form: Any citation written pursuant to this Chapter for enforcement of this Ordinance shall conform to the requirements of sec. 66.0113, Wis. Stats. (2003-2004). A person issued a citation for which a monetary forfeiture is provided for under this Ordinance may remit a forfeiture deposit of forty dollars (\$40.00) plus court costs. The forfeiture deposit, if made, shall be remitted to the Wood County Clerk of Courts, and a receipt shall be provided. The provisions of sec. 66.0113, Wis. Stats. (2003-2004) on the violator's options and procedure on default are hereby adopted.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication, as required by law.
