RE: Wood County Highway Department Restricted Access

Due to Governor Evers' Emergency Order to mitigate the spread of COVID-19, the Wood County Highway Department is limiting visitors to our facilities to those who have essential business transactions with the Department. Fuel pumps will remain accessible 24/7 to all departments as usual. Please contact our office at 715-421-8875 prior to visiting any Wood County Highway facility. Our staff is doing everything possible to assist you from making an unnecessary trip to our office.

As a recommendation from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services we are voluntarily canceling or limiting events that would bring together more than 10 people. We will continue to monitor the situation and respond to incidents with the same urgency as always. Our mission is to provide for safe, convenient movement of the traveling public in Wood County, and we will provide the highest service possible under the circumstances we are experiencing.

We will shift our hours of operation starting Monday, March 23 to 6:30 AM - 4:30 PM. Normal summer hours will go into effect on Monday, April 20, 2020 and those hours are 6:00 AM - 4:00 PM. If you must visit one of our facilities, please preserve social distancing of 6 feet between people, and follow all other public health recommendations issued by the Wisconsin Department of Health Services and the CDC. We will maintain these procedures for the duration of the public health emergency or until a subsequent order lifts these restrictions.
