5. Local Pandemic Update:

Dr. Falk presents information on the local pandemic. Death tolls are increasing. Hospitalizations are slightly better. 5 of 8 ICU beds are taken up with Covid 19 patients at this time. They are discharging patients sooner than normal for space needs. Also sending people home if they are ill and would have previously been admitted. Gave updates on the vaccine distribution and who will most likely get it when. Will need 75-80% vaccination rate to be successful. This vaccine will not stop the pandemic for approximately a year or so. Yes, even if you have had Covid you should get the vaccine. Community spread is the most prevalent. Only 7 cases of school children were found to be transmitted through the school.

For the month of December 2020, the total number of prohibited items prevented from entering the Courthouse are:

Some of the miscellaneous items that were located for the month were two empty holsters and miscellaneous tools.

Security Services screened 5,838 people entering the courthouse for the month of December. We handed out a total of 164 masks to individuals coming into the courthouse for the month. Security Services also had 34 security requests from different departments within the Courthouse.

On December 10th a Wood County Employee's vehicle was vandalized while it was parked on Avon St. Security Services used the security cameras to identify the offender. The information was forwarded to the Wisconsin Rapids Police Department, who issued a citation to the offender for criminal damage to property.

At the County Board meeting on December 15th, the board voted on a resolution to mandate that everyone that enters the Courthouse will need to wear a mask or entry will not be allowed unless permission is granted ahead of time. The resolution passed and the mandate started immediately. On December 21st, Security Services has to escort a male subject out of the building for refusing to wear his mask.

During the Month of December, I did utilize part-time employees for 43 hours to fill vacation time.
