## INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

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### May 2021

1. Wood County internet and intranet website updates concerning COVID-19 continue to be posted rapidly and continually as we work to keep employees and citizens informed.
2. Continued evaluating Parks Management and Reservations software solutions for suitability compared to the current in-house software. A decision about which package best fits the County's needs is expected in the near future.
3. Upgraded the central GIS system at the Courthouse to a new server operating system. Work was done in-house and our GIS and IT staff gained a lot of valuable experience. Further upgrades are planned in the near future to improve system security and performance.
4. Continued setup and testing of Laserfiche document management in the Human Services department. Non-clinical documents for Human Services, Norwood, and Edgewater will be migrated into the Laserfiche system over the coming months, and all related business units will begin using a paperless process as much as possible utilizing the Laserfiche software.
5. Worked with the Wood County Breastfeeding Coalition to move their website to a cloud-based service provider, resolving some security risks associated with local hosting.
6. The IT Security Team continues to expand the Security Awareness Program. To continue to remain in compliance with the KnowBe4 guarantee simulated Phishing tests need to be completed regularly, at minimum once a month.
7. Applied numerous updates to database servers. These updates include fixes for functionality and security patches to keep servers as secure as possible.
8. Support for Norwood Healthcare Center and Edgewater Haven Matrix software is ongoing. The Norwood Health upgrade to CareAssist implementation is complete. The upgrade to ePrescribing eliminates data transmission to pharmacy via fax with electronic, bidirectional, secure data transmission. Physicians now sign their orders electronically as well.

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9. Implementation of the RtVision OneGov permit system for additional permit types for the Highway Department continues. This permit system is available for public applications and payment processing on the Wood County website.
  10. Discovery phase continues for a system to provide an online property tax lottery credit search for property owners. The search utility will help reduce tax payer expense and increase county revenues.
  11. The TimeStar, electronic time card and time tracking, system configuration changes is ongoing. IT works to adjust settings as change requests occur. PBJ reports are submitted to CMS (Centers for Medicare & Medicaid) using TimeStar data for both the Edgewater and Norwood Facilities. TimeStar PBJ modifications for Norwood is being manually adjusted by IT before submission to CMS. Issues are due to Norwood's CMS facility ID integration for Norwood PBJ data submissions. IT works to train and setup new staff to track, generate and submit PBJ data to CMS.
  12. Preparation continues for legacy data migration from TCM to SmartCare. Currently working on writing a utility to pull client documents from IMS, convert them to PDFs, and allow them to be uploaded into SmartCare. Work also started reviewing how to convert the client notes from TCM to PDFs. Integrated SmartCare to the County's Active Directory. This will allow users to use Windows credentials to access the software instead of needing a separate username and password.
  13. Completed the state mandated Law Enforcement records conversion project. This was State and Federally mandated to have our CIS system converted to report incidents based off of NIBRS by the start of 2021. The State approved the grant to recover costs of project. Once payment is received, all agencies will be reimbursed.
  14. Providing continual support of Webex Meetings Webex Room Kit. – Due to COVID-19 additional measures were taken by the IT staff to support many remote worker daily operations. This included the increased use of video conferencing software and hardware. The County has been using Cisco Webex Meetings, Teams, and Roomkits for video conferencing as well as Cisco Jabber for phone access.

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15. SharePoint migration has been completed. All information has been transitioned off SharePoint and the server has been decommissioned.
16. For the month of April, 495 helpdesk requests were created, with staff completing 510 tickets and leaving 119 open requests. These numbers represent service requests from departments throughout the County. There are currently 301 project requests from departments.
17. Updated the County's virtual server environment to deal with a set of critical vulnerabilities that were identified by the MS-ISAC.
18. Assisted in scheduling and monitoring several committee meetings.
19. Microsoft identified more vulnerabilities with their Exchange email servers that required additional patching.
20. Continue to attend SmartCare implementation and Business Process Analysis meetings.
21. Updated Adobe Reader for all computers.
22. Began migrating Countywide Antivirus to a new platform to allow us better insight into possible compromises and better safeguard devices. This month included migrating all workstations and servers to the new platform.
23. Installed new network hardware at the Highway Department and River Block as part of our Network Refresh project from 2020. While installing the new network hardware, the virtual environment at both locations were upgraded as well.
24. Continued Exchange patching to ensure we are not at risk for the many vulnerabilities that have been exposed in the last several months.
25. Worked with Planning and Zoning to review and provide information for a new plotter purchase.

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26. Provide several communications to users regarding IT updates and changes.
27. Updated all computers to the latest version of Windows 10 in an ongoing effort to reduce our vulnerability to being attacked and keep our system up to date.
28. Working with Norwood Administration to complete implementation of InformCast, a mass communication software that Edgewater has been using for several months. This will allow them to quickly notify employees and resident families of things such as a covid outbreak in the facility, shifts that need to be filled due to sickness, or other critical information.
29. Continued to migrate to the new Mobile Device Management (MDM) platform. This has been implemented for all new cellular devices, Health Contact Tracers, and devices like iPads. This allows us to easily keep devices up to date and secure. We are also able to track and lock these devices in case they are lost. Created user instructions for installing our Mobile Device Management software on personal phones for email and WiFi access.
30. Completed the latest Sheriff's Department Body Camera and Squad Dash Camera (Arbitrator) system upgrade.
31. Continued in-house development for the new Non-Metallic Mining system for Land and Water Department.
32. Created multiple new templates and custom reports for the Law Enforcement Record system (CIS).
33. Hired an IT Intern, Jaren Mancl, who began employment May 24<sup>th</sup>.

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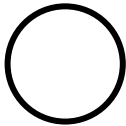
### Letter of Comments May 2021

- a) Jail – Participated in presenting information to the County Board that has been collected over the last several months and will help County Supervisors determine if a new jail facility will be constructed.

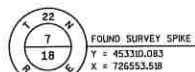
